For me, that occurred in the first week in March of this year. I want to join Ed in thanking and commending both George Baldwin and Tom Grafton for the heroic effort they are expending to get this group of 7th Engineer Battalion Veterans together again or in some cases for the first time.

If anyone has a better record or a picture of the ship after the war as a cruise ship I would like to have a copy. Also I would like to have a roster of A Company as of Jan. 1942. Hope all is well at the reunion and a “ Hello “ to all. (*Pat was Squad Leader, 1st. Squad, 2nd Platoon, B Company – my Squad -- T.T.)*

Roy Stroup wrote – Dear Orfield; I received a phone call two weeks after coming back home after our last reunion (Aug. 2000) which changed my life. I had a niece admitted to the University of Michigan hospital at Ann Arbor for a brain operation just a day or two before the reunion. I was living in Michigan for a short time after getting out of the service. Neither the mother or myself had any knowledge or the baby's existence through the years. On Sept. 18, 2000 I received a phone call and the lady asked me if I was Roy. I answered yes and she said she was my daughter. Three weeks after that first phone call I flew back to Detroit, rented a car, drove to my new found daughter's house and met my 54 year old daughter for the first. It was real emotional. I met her husband, my new son – in – law and we hit it off great. She has four daughters, 19years to 30 years old. All out of the house. Two married and the other two with boy friends. Met three of my grand daughters on my one week visit. Will be back in Michigan the first part of August to take my new

family to the Stroup family reunion on the farm in Mt. Clemens to meet their new cousins and aunts. My wife passed away last of Dec. 1999. I have two steps sons, four step grand sons, all living out here. So, my new daughter and grand daughters are my only blood children. 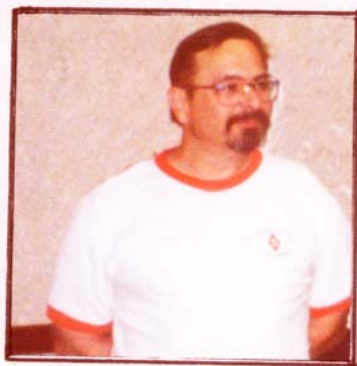
